

Clinton Pee Wee Football League Code of Conduct.

The Clinton Pee Wee Football League (hereunto referred to as CPFL) has adopted the following policy regarding code of conduct:

When a parent or guardian has an altercation with a coach or official (umpires, referees, scorekeepers, CPFL board members) that parent or guardian, along with the coach or official involved, will be placed on temporary suspension from the football fields until such time as the CPFL can review the evidence as presented by those involved, and a determination can be made.

If the CPFL determines the evidence confirms that the parent / guardian or coach or official is detrimental to the intent of the CPFL's efforts to provide quality sports entertainment; that person(s) will receive up to a three (3) year suspension from the ball park property.

An altercation includes but is not limited to, physical or verbal abuse.

Note: the following State Statue relating to the above code of conduct:

Any person with the purpose of causing physical injury to another person, who shall strike or otherwise physically abuse an athlete contest official immediately prior to , during, or following an interscholastic, intercollegiate, or any other organized amateur or professional athletic contest in which the athletic contest official is participating shall be guilty of (at least) a Class A misdemeanor
